A large crowd gathered for one of the greatest offerings of genetics that the Southwest has ever seen since the History in the Making Sale. Buyers from Texas, Missouri, Oklahoma, New Mexico, North Carolina, Florida, Iowa, South Dakota, Nebraska, Mississippi and Chihuahua, Mexico were on hand for the offering. The Performance Tested Bulls started the sale off with the high-selling bull consigned by the Morris/Box Ranch – Kelly and Sallye Box of Justin, Texas. MBR 6027 a LCC Major League A502M x a NEO-SHO Millennium 065G daughter, selling to Rollins Ranches of Okeechobee, Florida for \$3,000. The second-high selling bull was consigned by 3-J Farms LLC – Jeff and Jamie Earles of Ravia, Oklahoma. 3J Zakar T500 a Coley's Mojito 503R x BJR Make My Day 981 daughter, selling to Rollins Ranches of Okeechobee, Florida for \$2,950. Followed closely were two bulls selling for \$2,900 each: T5 Grade A 751 an OLC Daymaker P48 x LMAN King Rob 8321 daughter consigned by Long Creek Ranch – Raymond and Alyssa Anguiano of Bokchito, Oklahoma, along with BOLA Red Razor T2016 a BROWN-CH RedRaider 69M x BIM Julian Yoyo daughter, consigned by BOLA Red Angus – Ken and Marja Bower and Lane Ladewig of Forestburg, Texas both selling to selling to Roger Pack of Stephenville, Texas. Volume bull buyer was Rollins Ranches of Okeechobee, Florida with 12 head.

The exciting female offering was topped by Brown Ms Cherokee P7915, a January 2004 donor cow by BFCK Cherokee Cnyn 4912 x Brown Ms Make My Day K7 with a March 2008 LJC Javelin bull calf at-side. P7915 is a full sister in blood to the number one animal in the database for REA, Brown Revelation. Consigned by R. A. Brown Ranch – Donnell and Kelli Brown of Throckmorton, Texas and purchased by Lazy D Ranch – Mary Dobry of Hobbs, New Mexico for \$9,000. The second-high selling pair was PAR Stormy S1013, by PAR Gold Block A392A x PAR Southern Gal NA343 with a March 2008 LCB Lander 1205R heifer calf at-side. S1013 was consigned by Peacock Angus Ranch – Gary Peacock of Covington, Texas and sold to Ron Ashworth of San Augustine, Texas \$2,450.

C-Bar & Brown Jolene T704, a January 2007 open heifer by LJC Mission Statement P27 x HXC Jolene 301N consigned by C-Bar Ranch – Steve and Cynthia Maier of Brownell, Kansas and Brown Family Genetics – Donnell and Kelli Brown of Throckmorton, Texas, sold for \$6,200 to A-1 Land and Cattle – Tony Tolar of Muenster, Texas. C-Bar Ranch also had the second-high selling open female with C-Bar & Brown Carlene T718, a March 2007 heifer by LJC Lancer 806 x HXC Carlene 303N, selling for \$5,300 to R. A. Brown Ranch – Donnell and Kelli Brown of Throckmorton, Texas.

The high-selling bred female, a February 2004 cow, Brown Ms Major League P6867 by LCC Major League A502M x Brown Ms Golden Boy L67. P6867 was safe in-calf for an October due date to Brown Commitment S7206. Consigned by R. A. Brown Ranch – Donnell and Kelli Brown of Throckmorton, Texas and selling to Alexander Ag – Roddy Alexander of Roscoe, Texas for \$5,500. Ken Marquis of Ithaca, New York was the consignor of Brown Ms Cherokee R7511, a January 2005 female, that was safe in-calf to LJC Mission Statement P27 and sold to James Doss of Rockdale, Texas.

The embryo lots added a tremendous amount of excitement to the offering and the high-selling consignment from C-Bar Ranch – Steve and Cynthia Maier of Brownell, Kansas was the choice of five 5L Norseman King 2291 x Brown C-A502M AbiGrace R544 embryos selling to Morris/Box Ranch – Kelly and Sallye Box of Justin, Texas at \$800 each for a total of \$4,000. The next high-selling lot was a set of three embryos from Brown Commitment S7206 x Feddes Blockana 899, consigned by Ken Marquis of Ithaca, New York and sold to A-1 Land and Cattle – Tony Tolar of Muenster, Texas for \$825 each for a total of \$2,475. As a special lot, Flying M Ranch – Cody McCollum Family of Whiteright, Texas sold to Morris/Box Ranch – Kelly and Sallye Box of Justin, Texas a set of three LJC Javelin M08 x Brown Ms Logan L7742 embryos. L7742 is a full sister to the famed AbiGrace cow, selling for \$450 each for a total of \$1,350 all of the proceeds from this lot went to the Wayne Ferguson Memorial Fund. Volume registered female buyers of the day were PHM Ranch -- Peter and Helen Marten of Seminole, Texas with 11 head. Volume embryo buyers were Morris/Box Ranch – Kelly and Sallye Box of Justin, Texas purchasing 8 lots.

Commercial Red Angus Influenced Females made their inaugural showing this year and the top-selling Pairs were consigned by Smith Cattle – Gerry Smith of Gail, Texas. This set sold to Scott Riddle of Waco, Texas for \$1,335, followed by group of Broseco Ranches of Omaha, Texas Redline open females that sold for \$810 a round to Tony Ballinger of Stephenville, Texas. Volume commercial buyer of the day was James Dunn of Cleburne with 15 head.
